

Busan International Performing Arts Market Open call for the 2024 BPAM Next Stage

Busan International Performing Arts Market (BPAM) is a festival-style market that aims to be Asia's leading performing arts market.

Last year's Busan Performing Arts Market (BPAM) featured 92 exhibitors and 232 delegates over four days. This year's event will feature 200 exhibitors, 300 delegates, and 50,000 visitors over five days.

BPAM Next Stage is a program that offers new performing arts groups (individuals) with the opportunity to enter the performing arts market, aiming to discover artists with a vision for the performing arts and their creative works.

We are looking for new and challenging performances in dance, theater, music, and multidisciplinary arts that will create a new wave of performances never before seen in the global performing arts market. Any artist interested in participating in the event is welcome to apply.
